Public Act 89-191 requires school districts to provide the parents/guardians, of students with Individualized Education Plans, a copy of the Board Policy for use of behavior interventions in our schools. Board Policy Sections 7:230 and 2:150 address board policy regarding the misconduct of students with disabilities. A key component of PA 89-191 is that school districts also provide procedures to parents/guardians for behavior interventions in the schools.
